Supply chain dictionary

Allotment is a procurement process in which a supplier delivers products grouped in distinct lots to a single location, such as a warehouse or platform, for distribution to different final locations, usually stores.



Supply chain dictionary

This procurement method can be carried out from a single order called an "allotted order" or from several orders (one per final location) to be delivered at the same time to a single location (the "relay").



Supply chain dictionary

Allotment differs from batch picking in that multiple preparers work on a single customer order. This technique is commonly used to efficiently manage large quantities of products and optimize the distribution of products to different final locations.
